



Large meat processing firm save by ensuring CCA submissions and bills are correct

A large, multi-site meat processing company based in the UK were delighted when Brownlow Utilities yielded a saving of **£39,600** following a review of their Climate Change Agreement (CCA) submission figures.

The company had been reporting the figures for energy and production at each of their sites in the UK and were unfortunately failing their CCA targets.

The audit not only yielded the correct production and energy figures but also identified some billing errors. This has triggered a bill validation exercise which is ongoing and continues to generate tens of thousand pounds of savings and more accurate billing for our client.
